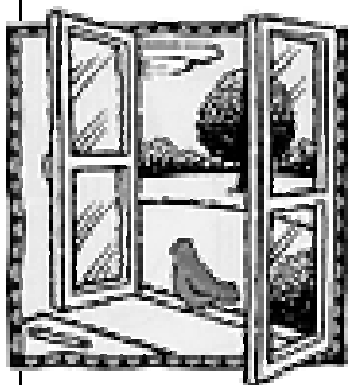
## Tips for Teachers
